

Genus *Mashunoides* Mendes & Bivar de Sousa, 2009 Marsh Ringlet

Entomologia Africana **14** (2): 5 (5-9).

Type-species: *Mashunoides carneiromendesi* Mendes & Bivar de Sousa 2009, by original designation.

The genus *Mashunoides* belongs to the Family Nymphalidae Rafinesque, 1815; Subfamily Satyrinae Boisduval, 1833; Tribe Satyrini Boisduval, 1833; Subtribe Ypthimina, Reuter, 1896. The other genera in the Subtribe Ypthimina in the Afrotropical Region are *Ypthima*, *Ypthimomorpha*, *Mashuna*, *Strabena*, *Neocoenyra*, *Coenyropsis*, *Coenyra*, *Neita*, *Melampias*, *Cassionympha*, *Pseudonympha*, *Paternympha* and *Stygionympha*.

Mashunoides (**Marsh Ringlet**) is an Afrotropical genus containing a single species. It is a monobasic genus so far only known from Angola.
